- Accepted abstracts will be notified by e-mail
- 3 prizes will be given to the best 3 presenters
 - o First Prize: RM1000
 - o Second: RM500
 - o Third: RM300
- Marks will be given according to the following scheme:
 - o Abstract 50%
 - o Presentation 50%
 - Idea/Innovative
 - Design and Methods. Is it case series, descriptive, retrospective, case-control, prospective, or randomized control trial?
 - Is the design of the study answering the hypothesis/objectives/research question
 - Are the results presented appropriately? Does the result answer the research question?
 - Is the conclusion: appropriately drawn and relevant?
 - Language and presentation
- Each accepted abstract will be given 8 minutes for oral presentation and 2 minutes for question and answer. A power point presentation will be available (single projection only)
- The decision of the panel of judges is final and not subject to appeal
