- Abstract should not exceed 300 words and should contain within the border of the abstract form
- Abstract must be typed in Times New Roman font and of size 12 point
- The abstract should be organized along the following headings:
 - Title : (should not exceed more than 2 lines)
 - Authors: (Surname followed by initials only. Underline the name of presenter. Do not include degrees or titles)
 - Institution : (Institution where the work originated)
 - Introduction : Objective :
 - Methods Results
 - Conclusion
- Accepted abstracts will be notified by e-mail

 - Are the results presented appropriately? Does the result answer the research question?
 - Is the conclusion: appropriately drawn and relevant?

- Each accepted abstract will be given 8 minutes for oral presentation and 2 minutes for question and answer. A power point presentation will be available (single projection only)
- The decision of the panel of judges is final and not subject to appeal
